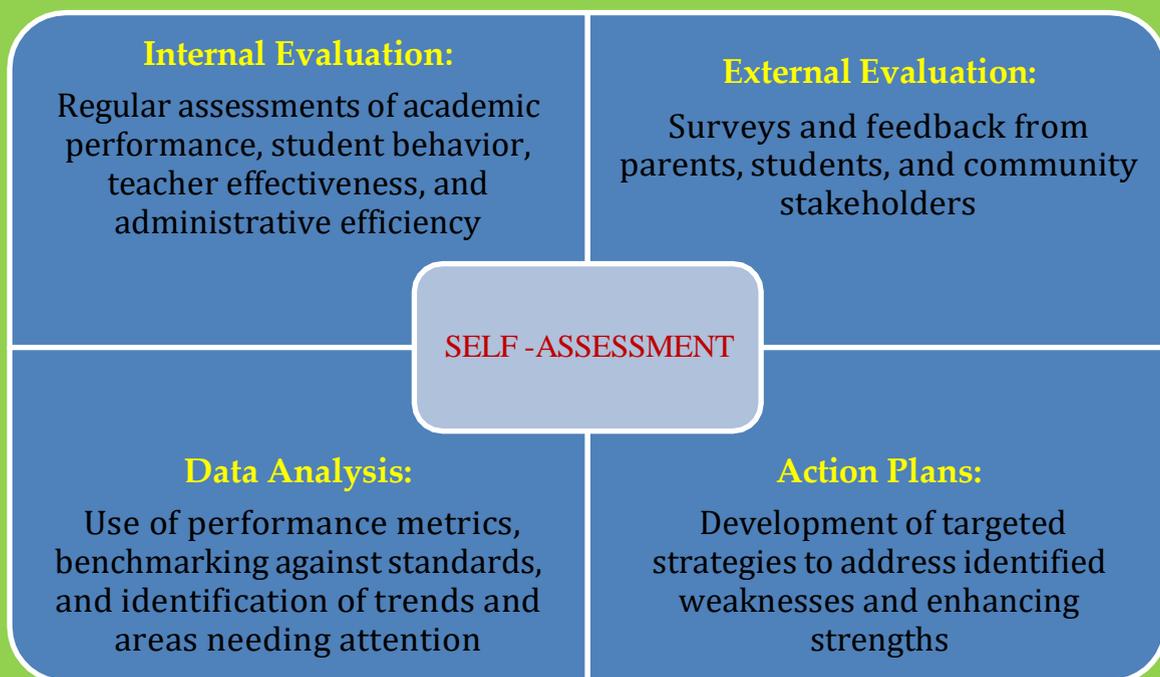
## [School Development Matrix]

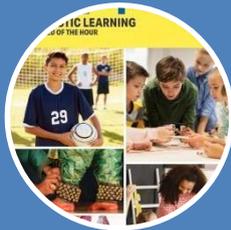
**Objective:** Promote comprehensive student growth by integrating life skills, social-emotional learning, and active participation.

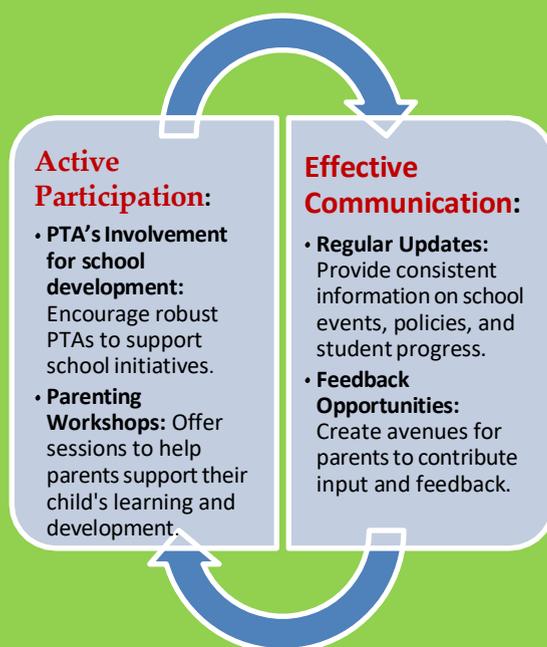
